Who We Are

The World Federation of Right To Die Societies presently consists of 45 member organizations from 24 countries.

The Federation was founded in 1980 at Oxford, England at the third international conference of national right-to-die societies. The first meeting was held in 1976 in Tokyo, after the formation of what is now the Japan Society for Dying with Dignity.

The Federation believes that individuals should have the right to make their own choices as to the manner and timing of their own death. Each of our member societies is working in its own way to secure this right.

Our belief in independent choice extends to our member societies. As a Federation of many different right to die societies, we support all of our member organizations in their work to achieve their own objectives. We do not require them to adhere to a specific belief or goal other than supporting a person's right to a dignified death.

The objectives and work of our member societies depend on existing laws within their countries and how they define the needs of individuals. Some of our members work to promote laws for living wills or other advance medical directives, while other societies focus on obtaining the legal right to physician aid-in-dying, either physician-assisted suicide or voluntary euthanasia.

What We Do

The World Federation of Right To Die Societies:

- Provides information about physician-assisted dying, voluntary euthanasia, living wills, other right-to-die issues, and related matters of interest.
- Promotes co-operation and liaison among our member societies and with other organizations.
- Facilitates conferences on issues related to death and dying, the right to die, and compassionate care for the dying.
- Gives assistance to groups and individuals interested in establishing right-to-die societies in countries where they do not currently exist.
- Responds to requests by groups, scholars, and individuals for information about various right-to-die issues.
- Meets every two years at an international conference hosted by one of our member societies.
