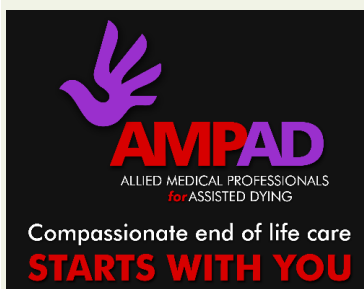
### **Student Sponsorship**
