

## **Update on my case**

*My legal team have busily been preparing evidence to file in my case. There are 14 people who are giving evidence in support of my case as well as 11 experts. The expert evidence comes from experts on assisted dying from the USA, Canada, New Zealand, Belgium, Switzerland and the Netherlands and it shows that it is fair and proportionate for the law to be changed; and that weak and vulnerable people will not suffer. Also that safeguards can be devised and are available in other countries.*

*This has been a huge task for my legal team and I would like to thank them for the tremendous work and effort that they have put in to getting this evidence finalised.*

*It will now be over to the Government to file any evidence that they want to file in response. We know that the government will try and argue - as they did in the Conway case last week - that it's not constitutionally appropriate to bring the case at all and that the Court should not hear it and that it's a matter for Parliament.*

*I will be absolutely gutted if they succeed in this argument because Parliament has never even considered the position of people like me - those who have an incurable condition and years of pain and suffering ahead. The only debates in recent years have been around people with terminal illness and 6 months or less to live. My lawyers have done all that they can for now.*
